This position is responsible for maintaining all environmental equipment, reporting and documenting environmental conditions impacting the facility, and is the key driver in creating a culture dedicated to safety.

Responsibilities

- Implement plant and company-wide safety policies and procedures
- Track and analyze workplace injuries and illnesses, with special emphasis on determining root causes and implementing corrective actions and prevention strategies
- Perform industrial hygiene surveys, including study design, data gathering, interpretation of results, development and implementation of recommendations, report writing and communication to workers and management
- Report quarterly to Government all reports pertaining to air, water and hazardous waste
- Direct the Emergency Response Team
- Implement, monitor and maintain systems to ensure compliance with local, state and federal occupational safety and health regulations and to reduce the potential for occupational injuries, illnesses and incidents
- Inspect or tour company facilities to detect existing or potential accident, health and environmental hazards and recommend corrective or preventive measure where indicated
- Alert managers and employees on the hazards of working with toxic fumes, dangerous chemicals and any other hazardous substances
- Participate in the investigation of accidents and injuries and cooperate in the preparation of material and evidence for organizational use in hearings, law suits and insurance investigations
- Responsible for hazardous waste disposal procedures, government reports, training and record keeping, emergency planning and liaison with local emergency agencies

- Conduct or ensure appropriate safety training at all levels including: lock-out tag-out, confined space, hazmat, ergonomics, laser safety awareness and fire protection
- Manage workers compensation claims and the direction of care
